The Court has revised its Internal Operating Procedures to more accurately reflect how the court sets its calendar and assembles panels, and to remove certain restrictions on the circulation of en banc petitions.

I.O.P. 34(a)(1) is amended with respect to the selection of panels and with respect to setting the annual sitting schedule.

I.O.P. 34(b)(1) is abrogated and subsequent subsections are renumbered accordingly. New subsection 34(b)(2) is amended with respect to the drawing of replacement judges.

I.O.P. 35(g) is abrogated.
